#### **A look back...**

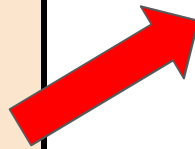

#### **Winter Show and Reception**

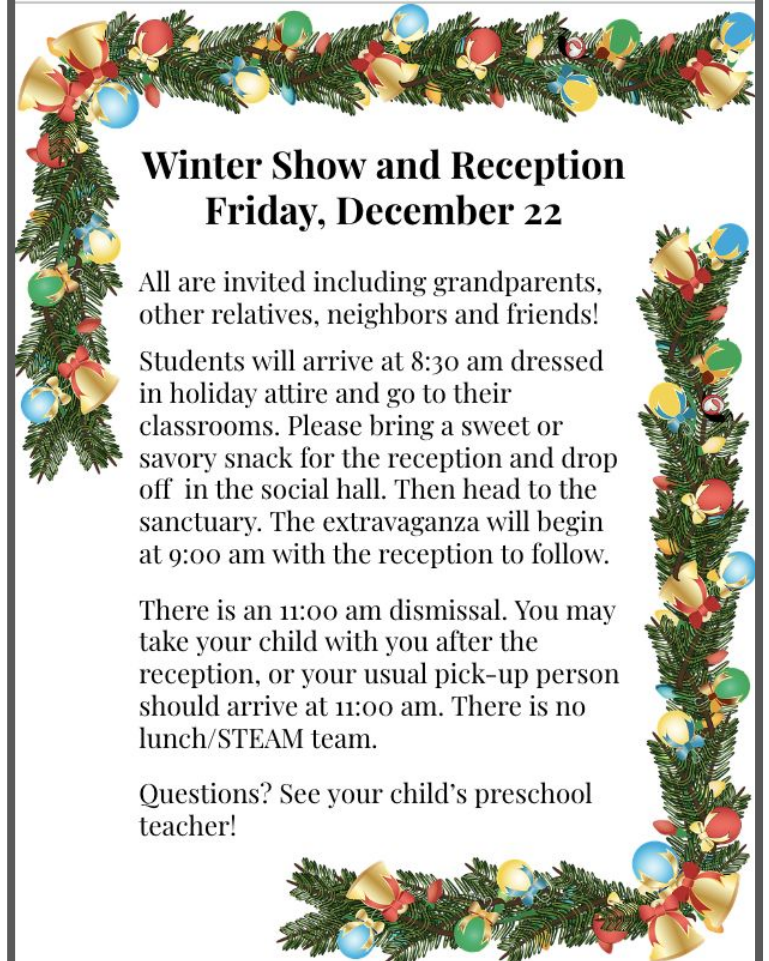
##### **Friday, December 22**
