Theme: Weather & Rainbows

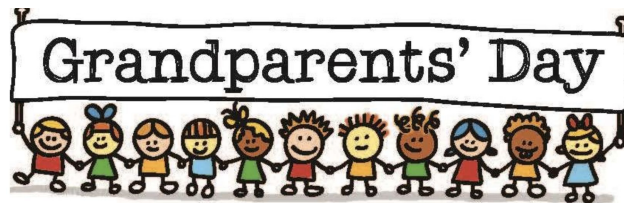
Weekly Recap
